CharIN e.V. publishes Certificate Policy guideline for an ISO 15118 V2G PKI

Charln's **CP for ISO 15118 V2G PKI** is a guideline that defines the minimum requirements for a dedicated PKI implementation guaranteeing a sufficient level of security. The document is supposed to help and accelerate the market rollout of the **Plug and Charge** feature.



The Task Force PKI consists of numerous experts all coming from companies that are involved in the Plug and Charge environment such as OEMs, EVSEs, CPOs, eMSPs, and IT security. Therefore, this consolidated cross-industry document represents a **reliable guideline for the PKI implementation** in systems using ISO 15118.
